DISABLED FRIENDLY (DIVYANGJAN) ENVIRONMENT POLICY

Preamble:

The main priorities of Loyola College of Arts & Science (Co. Ed.) are the right of every student to an inclusive education free from discrimination and the necessity of meeting their educational needs. Students with learning disabilities are supported equally by the college. This initiative was taken specifically to foster a welcoming and supportive atmosphere. The Policy was developed by the college with the understanding that people with disabilities are its most important stakeholders. It offers equal opportunities, protection, and full participation in academic events.

Scope:

The college offers students with disabilities post-secondary education. It adheres to the admissions procedure in accordance with Tamil Nadu government norms, regulations, and policies. Upon enrollment, a single place is reserved for students with exceptional needs in every program.

Operating Aspects:

The College guarantees reasonable convenience to fulfill the needs of students with disabilities. Students should notify the principal in advance if they require a scribe. The Coordinator of Examinations will get the list of students. Candidates with disabilities are granted additional time during the semester examination. As per the University policies, a different seating arrangement is allowed.

The Principal may appoint scribes in accordance with the following guidelines in order to use their services.

- The scribe ought not to be a college employee or a student pursuing the same major.
- The student with a disability's relative shouldn't be the scribe.
- The scribe's educational background ought to be lower than that of the student with a disability.

Responsibilities:

It is important for other students to be aware of the unique requirements of students with disabilities and to motivate them to help by making every attempt to include them in class discussions, projects, and other activities. Ensuring their active involvement in cultural events is vital.

It is important to consider the requirements of students with disabilities when it comes to reading and learning. There are audio CDs available.

Implementation:

- On the college grounds, ramps and handrails, and lifts are easily accessible and handicapped-accessible, facilitating the mobility of students with special needs.
- For students who are physically challenged, wheelchairs are available to assist them in getting to their destinations.
- For pupils with disabilities, separate restrooms with grab bars and easy access are set up. Students with disabilities can roam around freely in the toilets.
- The establishment boasts a barrier-free, handicapped-friendly atmosphere.

Approval and Review:

The Disabled Friendly (DIVYANGJAN) Environment Policy will be examined every three years or more frequently as needed. The Policy will be maintained by the College Principal.
